## FANTASTIC OPPORTUNITY

Have you noticed how snappy the photos and ads are in the latest issue of the Gazette? That's the work of Michelle Frehsee, professional photographer and Photoshop expert. Michelle will share her knowledge with us in two series of workshops.

The first series will be on using Photoshop (a photo editing computer program) in May. The workshops will be held on Tuesday nights beginning at 6:30, May 5, 12, 19, and 26. You can use a library computer, or bring your own with Photoshop loaded on it.

There is no charge to participate, but you must register. Register early, because space is limited. When you register you'll be asked to complete a short survey of your knowledge/experience of Photoshop, so that the workshops can be tailored to participant needs. The second series of workshops will be on using InDesign, which is desktop publishing software.

In the end you'll have basic knowledge for newsletters and touching up photographs. And then maybe you'll want to help with Gazette production. (That is NOT a requirement.)
